

Statement of Disciplinary Procedure Policy

Children feel most secure in an environment where boundaries of acceptable behavior are clearly defined and established. Each counselor accepts the responsibility for explaining guidelines of acceptable behavior to campers and for maintaining them. Good discipline is always positive in nature. Counselors promote a positive attitude towards good citizenship by working to help each child develop self-discipline, self-respect and the respect of others. When a child's actions are contrary to his welfare or that of others, some disciplinary measures must follow. Minor infractions are handled by the counselors present when the action occurs. These are occasions when a short time out period is indicated for the child to regroup. If inappropriate behavior persists, a child may be sent to the Pre-school Coordinator for a discussion of acceptable modes of behavior. We may initiate an individualized behavior modification program for the child, always emphasizing positive reinforcement. Repeated infractions warrant a parental, counselor, coordinator and Director's meeting to determine the best mode of reversing the inappropriate behavior being exhibited.
